Post and Rail Fencing – Most commonly found on a property containing horses, this fence works to keep large animals enclosed whilst achieving an aesthetically-pleasing look.



Cattle Yard Panels and Fence – Almost exclusively used for enclosing horses and cattle, cattle yards are made of steel, have several gates and often feature a ramp which can assist in loading animals into trucks.



Wire Fence – Cost-effective and durable, a wire fence can keep your animals contained or discourage unwanted visitors from trespassing. Wire, whether plain wire through posts, wire mesh, or any combination, are visually unobtrusive yet still provide a clear boundary for anyone wandering nearby.



Hinge Joint Fencing – Designed to build areas for animals, such as netting, chicken wire, chain mesh and farm lock, are all used primarily in farm settings. However, you may want one of these types of fences, particularly chicken wire, to surround your garden because it is unobtrusive and helps to keep vermin away from your vegetables.



Farm Electric Fences – Great for keeping aggressive livestock within a specified area, a Farm Electric fence may also be used for security, but is often not permitted in residential areas.
